Professional Engineer Application Checklist

Applicants applying for licensure are **strongly encouraged to use this checklist** to ensure all required documents* are included with their Professional Engineer application.

<input type="checkbox"/> Confirmed Qualifications	Qualifying experience must be completed by the final filing date for the chosen exam cycle.
<input type="checkbox"/> Reviewed Application Instructions	Get answers to many questions asked by applicants.
<input type="checkbox"/> Application for Licensure	Applications must be filled out in their entirety. Wet signatures on all pages are required. Hand written forms are not accepted.
<input type="checkbox"/> Application and State Exam Fees	Payment made by check or money order.
<input type="checkbox"/> Copy of Completed Live Scan Form or Fingerprint Cards	All applicants are required to provide proof of fingerprinting when submitting applications.
<input type="checkbox"/> License and/or Exam Verification	Create or Log in to your NCEES account to request license/exam verification.
<input type="checkbox"/> Official, Sealed College Transcripts	Submit transcripts for all engineering degrees to claim education credit.**
