Another new year brings with it more opportunity to continue moving forward in our mission to regulate the valued professions this Board has the privilege to be associated with. If you had the chance to read the Board's summer 2024 *Bulletin*, and generally follow the activities of the Board, you will find that we successfully completed our latest **Sunset Report**. The Board's sunset date has been extended to January 1, 2029. As is often the case, when the Legislature takes the time to perform this statutory review of regulatory entities, it is done in a collaborative effort between the Legislature, the Board, the Department of Consumer Affairs, and the Board's stakeholders. Most people tend to think of "stakeholders" as specific groups who have an interest in the Board's daily affairs. However, it is important to understand that consumers—the general public—is our largest stakeholder.

This time, the collaborative sunset effort resulted in a few revisions to the Board's statutes primarily intended to provide additional or clarifying protections for the public through the services offered and performed by the Board's licensees. There is an additional article in this *Bulletin* that provides more details about the revisions.

Thank you to all the licensees for doing what you do. We appreciate your interest in providing your services in a timely, efficient, and quality manner to the public.

In August 2024, BPELSG signed the Mutual Recognition Agreement with the United Kingdom and NCEES as a Participating Board, which will allow qualified professional engineers to practice across the pond. Our Board is in the process of creating a pathway for engineers in the U.K. to practice in California.

In October 2024, the Board met to update our **Strategic Plan** to incorporate the elements of Diversity, Equity and Inclusion, enriching and furthering our positive and engaging work environment for our staff, applicants, licensees, and stakeholders.

Board members are also active nationally, participating in various committee roles in the National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying (NCEES). I have the pleasure to serve as the Chair of the Nominating Committee of the Western Zone in 2024–25. Additionally, I have been appointed as a member of the Finance Committee of NCEES. I sincerely appreciate NCEES embracing and valuing public members!

In 2024, Governor Gavin Newsom appointed Khaesha Brooks, Mechanical Engineer Member, and Cliff Waldeck, Public Member, as the newest Board members of BPELSG. Ms. Brooks and Mr. Waldeck bring their wealth of knowledge, experience, and unique perspective to the Board. We extend the warmest welcome to them.

Looking forward, we will continue our dedication to public protection. It is my belief that California is safer because of the integrity and excellent quality of work our Board delivers.

2025 Board Changes to the Law

Effective January 1, 2025, AB 1862 and AB 3253 made substantive and non-substantive changes to the Professional Engineers Act, Professional Land Surveyors' Act, and the Geologist and Geophysicist Act. The Laws and Regulations section of the Board's website will be updated to reflect all changes; notable ones are listed below:

- We are pleased to announce that the Board's Sunset date has been extended to January 1, 2029.
- Businesses that offer civil, electrical, and mechanical engineering, and land surveying services will be required to include with the filing of an Organization Record form documentary evidence to demonstrate compliance with Business and Professions Code sections 6738 and 8729.
- Written contracts for professional engineering, land surveying, geology, and geophysical services (required by sections 6749, 8759, and 7839.2) must include the disclosure of a current professional liability insurance policy covering the licensee in responsible charge of the services, if there is one. NOTE: This change does NOT require licensees to hold a professional liability insurance policy—only that it be disclosed if there is one.
- Provisions of sections 8771 and 8773 have been changed to require licensed land surveyors (or civil engineers licensed prior to January 1, 1982) to reconstruct or rehabilitate monumentation found to be less than permanent or durable to as permanent a state as reasonably possible.
- There is no longer a minimum age required to be appointed as a Board member.
- Businesses will continue to be permitted to operate limited liability partnerships.

Citations are an alternative to criminal prosecutions that the Board can use to enforce the laws prohibiting the unlicensed practice of engineering, land surveying, geology, and geophysics, or other activities for which a license is required. When a fine is levied with a citation, payment of the fine does not constitute admission of any violations charged but represents a satisfactory resolution of the matter pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.9(d). Code sections numbered in the 6700s, 7800s, and 8700s refer to the Business and Professions Code; those numbered in the 400s and 3000s refer to Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations. Formal Administrative Disciplinary Decisions: Fiscal Year 2023-24 (July–March)

A formal disciplinary decision is considered formal administrative disciplinary action against a licensee. It results from the Board’s adoption of a proposed decision prepared by an administrative law judge following a hearing, a stipulated settlement agreement, or a default decision following a full investigation and the filing of an accusation. An accusation is a formal legal document that notifies a licensee of the Board’s charges and allegations of violations against the licensee and that requests a disciplinary order be issued. The licensee is entitled to contest the charges at a formal hearing before an administrative law judge or to agree to a stipulated settlement. A final disciplinary decision contains findings and determinations or statements of advisements, waivers, and culpability and a disciplinary order. If there are findings of violations, the order may include revocation or suspension of the license, a stayed revocation or suspension of the license with a probationary period and terms and conditions of probation, or a public reproof. In the alternative, the decision may find that no violations or violations of a de minimus nature occurred and order the dismissal of the accusation. All final disciplinary decisions are matters of public record.
